Installing UCL Unicode Phonetic Keyboard on Windows 10

- Download executable installation from http://www.phon.ucl.ac.uk/resource/phonetics/phonetickbd110.exe
- 2. Run the program as administrator to install the keyboard. You will get a message about a missing instructions file. Ignore this.
- 3. Once the keyboard has been installed, run Windows settings by clicking on the Windows icon and typing "Settings".
- 4. Select "Time and Language"
- 5. Select "Region and Language". You will need to enter Adminstrator password
- 6. Select "English (United Kingdom)".
- 7. Select "Options" you should see "Unicode Phonetic Keyboard" listed.
- 8. Click back-arrow to get back to Region and Language
- 9. Select "Advanced keyboard settings"
- 10. Check that "Use the desktop language bar" is enabled.
- 11. Click "Language bar options"
- 12. Check "Language bar Docked in taskbar" is enabled
- 13. Check "Show additional Language bar icons in the taskbar" is enabled
- 14. Check "Show text labels on the Language bar" is enabled
- 15. You should see a keyboard icon in the task bar and clicking on this allows you to switch between the normal keyboard and the phonetic keyboard.
- 16. If the default language is not English (United Kingdom) you will need to select that language first by clicking on the language name in the task bar.
